

LCA PARENT/GUARDIAN CONTRACT

Please sign and date below after reading this document, indicating that you understand and accept.

LCA is delighted that you have chosen to entrust your child's education with us and we want this year to be a great experience for your family. To help facilitate this, we've outlined a few concepts that are important to us. Should you disagree, you have the right to withdraw your child if a situation arises in which a resolution cannot be jointly attained.

LCA is proud of its highly trained and academically qualified teachers who are committed to high Christian ideals. Teachers are deserving of respect by both students and parents to help produce a sound instructional environment. However, a teacher's position of relative authority does not carry with it the right to treat students or parents unfairly or in an unchristian manner. If you feel that you or your child has been treated unfairly or with disrespect, please refer to the LCA Student Handbook for details on the conflict resolution procedure and follow the steps recommended by the Georgia-Cumberland Conference.

LCA is proud of its students and strives to maintain an atmosphere conducive to learning as well as physical, spiritual and emotional well being. To help achieve this balance, LCA maintains certain behavior and academic standards. Students who cannot reasonably hold themselves to the established codes of conduct or do not take their academic responsibilities seriously will be asked to leave. Neither behavioral nor academic uncooperativeness will be tolerated, as such behaviors can quickly affect other students. Occasionally, enrolled children pose no behavioral problems but lack the academic strength required to function in our classrooms. While we strive to help all students, our teachers are not trained to help children with certain academic challenges. The Georgia-Cumberland Conference recommends that LCA refer such students to a school where special assistance is available. From the day of enrollment, all new students enter under a six-week behavioral and academic probation. However, extreme cases of behavioral or academic struggles may be dealt with in a shorter timeframe. Please understand that maintaining our student standards is what helps provide the quality education that LCA offers our youth.

LCA is proud of its parents and enjoys friendships gained through interaction with them. We strive to develop a facility and academic program worthy of your trust. We need you to help make that happen. Through your volunteering and assistance, you are an integral key to the success of our program. We value your input and suggestions, but please understand that we can only incorporate a limited number of ideas into our already packed schedule and curriculum. However, we will take your thoughts seriously and use your ideas whenever appropriate and possible.

Thank you for your time and consideration in these matters. We fully expect to have a wonderful year, and want you to feel comfortable with and confident in the policies of this school. Please keep your Student Handbook close for reference throughout the year, and remember that the LCA staff is only a phone call away. You and your family will be in our prayers throughout the year, and we hope you will keep us in yours.
